- Tyler shared that Galaxie has been very active, outreach activities organized or participated include outdoor story times at Kelly Park, National Fire Prevention Week, Autism Acceptance Month etc. Currently Galaxie is gearing up for Summer Discovery and planning for in-person summer programing, outdoor events at Kelly Park, youth programing, craft fairs, writers' workshops among others.
- Russ provided the Committee with information pertaining to Materials Selection. DCL
 possesses more than 785,000 physical items and have access to more than 45,000 titles in
 digital content via OverDrive and Libby. In 2022, circulation or checkouts amounted to more

than 5 million. He and Julie also provided other information involving collection management, selection criteria as well as purchasing digital collections through Libby and Hoopla.

- The meeting also discussed a request for Reconsideration of Material. After much deliberation, the Committee recommended to Margaret that the title "This Book is Gay" should continue to be kept in the Teens section.
- Margaret reported that the Board was provided various information pertaining to the Selfservice Hours pilot at Farmington Library but has yet to make any decision.

The event was very successful, attracting 300 in-person attendees while another 100 participated virtually. Kevin shared that Wentworth will be involved in bike events like the Bike Rodeo and the West St Paul Rider, as well as participating in the Garlough Environmental Fair and the Moreland Arts & Health Sciences Magnet School events.
