Safety Tips

What to wear:

- Heavy gloves
- Leather shoes or boots
- Light colored clothing and brightly-colored caps
- Wear a long-sleeved shirt along with your safety vest provided by the Dakota County Transportation Department or the department-approved vest provided by your group leader
- Use sunscreen and insect repellent

Before you go:

- Schedule your pick up for daylight hours
- Reschedule if the weather looks threatening
- Review the safety precautions and take them seriously.
- Distribute trash bags.
- Agree on a meeting place.
- Bring along a supply of drinking water.

While you work:

- 1. Limit your area to the shoulders; do not clean the median.
- 2. Whenever possible, face oncoming traffic.
- 3. Stay alert and be prepared to move out of the way.
- 4. Stay with your team.
- 5. Do not wear headsets that could prevent you from hearing traffic.
- 6. Do not crush collected trash. Broken or jagged objects could cause accidental injuries.
- 7. Do not horse around or do anything to purposely distract drivers.

What to avoid:

Construction sites Bridge overpasses Recently-applied pesticides Hypodermic needles Syringes Mowing activities Dead animals Heavy or large materials Abandoned barrels Any sharp objects

Open water Poison ivy Covered containers Paint Weapons
