

Rules & Conditions

1. A permit is required to use the Dog Park. The permit must be displayed as defined on the permit.
2. Dogs must be under the direct control of the owner/handler at all times - with no exceptions. Dogs must be trained and responsive to voice commands to prevent aggressive behavior, fighting, biting, and excessive barking. Aggressive behavior is not acceptable.
3. No more than two dogs per handler are allowed within the Dog Park at any given time.
4. Children (under the age of 15) must be closely supervised by parents and should be instructed about proper behavior around dogs.
5. Do not bring food or dog toys into the Dog Park. They can create conflict.
6. Closely monitor dogs playing together. Talk to other dog owners to make sure the play is appropriate for dogs.
7. Dogs must be on a leash prior to entering and upon exiting the DWDP.
8. Cruelty toward any animals is not allowed, including punishing other people's dogs.
9. Owner/handler must remain in the area with their dogs at all times.
10. Owner/handler must have a leash visible and available for quick use at all times.
11. Owner/handler must clean up their pets waste immediately and dispose of it in a proper manner in a designated waste container using a plastic bag.
12. Dogs must be properly licensed and vaccinated. Dog must display a valid license. Owner/handler must have a certificate of current rabies vaccination for all pets using the area.
13. Dogs under four months of age are not allowed.
14. Dogs in heat are not allowed.
15. Owners/handlers are liable for damage or injury inflicted by their dogs.
16. Smokers must not discard their smoking materials inside Dakota Woods Dog Park.
17. Owner/handler and other visitors must abide by all other park rules and Park Ordinance 107.
18. Dogs declared dangerous under Minnesota law or by local community in which the Dog Park is located are not allowed.
19. Use of firearms is prohibited.

Dakota County reserves the right to reject/cancel permits for any reason and will restrict days/times of use as necessary.

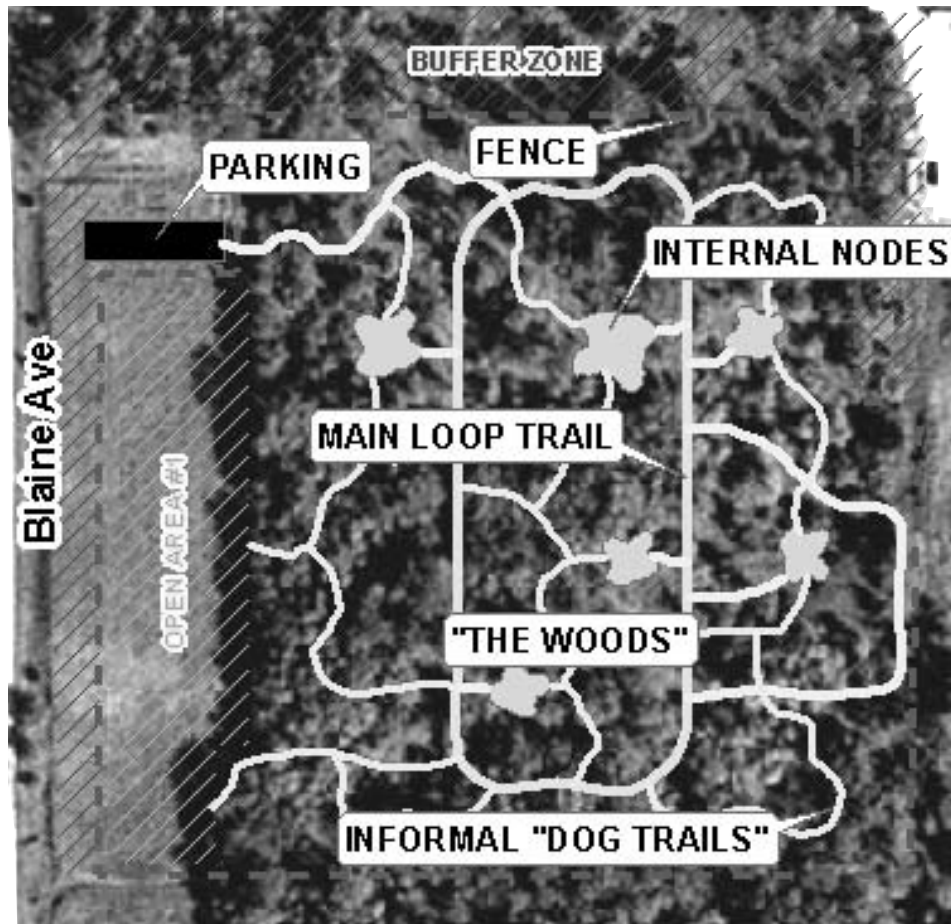

Dakota Woods Dog Park

The Dakota Woods Dog Park is a 16-acre, fenced site that provides ample space for dogs to exercise. The site is composed primarily of mixed woods with three acres of open space. A dog-walking trail loop connects the wooded areas to the open space.

Only those dog owners who have purchased a permit can exercise their dogs in this area.
