If the event will require closure of the traveled portion of the roadway or shoulder, the Permittee must submit a traffic management plan along with this permit form. A minimum of two weeks prior public notification is required if a traffic detour will be needed. The Permittee must also notify and coordinate this activity with the local Police Department and/or Dakota County Sheriff's Department. No lane closures are permitted during weekday rush hour times from: 6:00 a.m. to 8:30 a.m. and from 3:30 p.m. to 6:00 p.m. in the following cities: Apple Valley, Burnsville, Eagan, Farmington, Hastings, Inver Grove Heights, Lakeville, Mendota, Mendota Heights, Rosemount, South St. Paul, Sunfish Lake and West St. Paul, without prior approval. All detours and/or lane closures shall conform to the provisions of the Minnesota Manual on Uniform Traffic Control Devices. The event shall not be detrimental to the highway or to the Safety of the Public. This permit cannot be assigned, transferred or subcontracted to others without the written consent of Dakota County.

The Permittee agrees to obtain a Commercial General Liability insurance policy and have Dakota County named as an additional insured on the policy. The Permittee shall hold Dakota County harmless and indemnify Dakota County from any and all claim demands and causes of action arising from permit holder's use of the County road, including any attorney's fees and costs related thereto to the extent permitted by Minnesota Law. A Certificate of Insurance listing Dakota County as an additional insured on the Permittee's Commercial General Liability policy must be provided prior to the Permittee's obstruction of the County road. The certificate must be in place 10 days prior the event and provide minimum limits of \$ 1,000,000 per occurrence and aggregate.
