



CONSTRUCTION UPDATE

2009 Dakota County Overlays

May 7, 2009

Thank you for your patience while we make improvements to the surface of the roadway.

WHAT'S BEING DONE?

Each year Dakota County rehabilitates approximately 25 miles of pavement. The 2009 overlays include work on County Roads 5, 28, 30, 32, 42, 46, 54, 70, 73 and the Spring Lake Park entrance. A map is attached on the backside of this update showing the construction locations.

This year's contractor, Valley Paving Inc, will be placing new asphalt on the driving lanes and in most cases the shoulders of the roads. The end product will be a better looking, longer lasting and smoother roadway.

WHEN WILL WORK TAKE PLACE?

Work at the intersection of County Road 28 and County Road 31 is scheduled to begin the week of May 11. The right turn lane on northbound County Road 31 will be reconstructed, and the signal system will be revised. This work will take about two weeks to complete.

WHAT SHOULD I EXPECT?

The right turn lane on northbound County Road 31 will be closed. Other temporary lane closures may be necessary to complete the work. While the contractor performs these operations, you may encounter a short delay. For the safety of both the residents and the workers, we ask for your patience.
