



CONSTRUCTION UPDATE

County Road 70

July 8, 2009

Thank you for your patience while we make important improvements to increase safety and improve traffic flow at the County Road 70/I-35 interchange.

WHAT'S BEING DONE?

Construction continues on the bridge over I-35, the ramps and loops, County Road 70, and Keokuk Avenue north of County Road 70. However, areas that are complete are scheduled to reopen to traffic.

WHEN WILL WORK TAKE PLACE?

A portion of County Road 70 east of the bridge is scheduled to reopen to traffic on Monday, July 13. Kenrick Avenue and the remainder of the northbound I-35 exit ramp will also open to traffic at this time.

WHAT SHOULD I EXPECT?

County Road 70 from Kenrick Avenue to the east will be one lane in each direction. Kensington Avenue and County Road 5 will continue to have one lane in each direction, and there will be a four-way stop at the intersection with County Road 70 until the signal system is operational.

Kenrick Avenue and the rest of the northbound I-35 exit ramp will also open at this time. As a result, the temporary roadway will be removed and traffic will no longer be able to exit directly into the McStop area.

Northbound I-35 access will continue to be from Kenrick Avenue. Access to and from southbound I-35 will remain unchanged. County Road 70 will continue to be detoured until the bridge and the remainder of County Road 70 is complete. Please see the back of this sheet for the detour route.

Access to residences and businesses will remain open throughout construction. Trucks requiring access onto County Road 70 from I-35 should continue to follow the posted truck detour.
