



# CONSTRUCTION UPDATE

## County Road 96

May 3, 2010

Thank you for your patience while we make important improvements to County Road 96.

### WHAT'S BEING DONE?

County Road 96 from County Road 23 (Eveleth Avenue) to Trunk Highway 3 is being reconstructed. The current gravel road will be reconstructed to a two-lane paved roadway with paved shoulders. In addition, the two railroad crossings on County Road 96 will be reconstructed and outfitted with flashing warning lights. Private utilities (underground and overhead) will also be relocated further away from the roadway.

### WHEN WILL WORK TAKE PLACE?

A segment of County Road 23 will close to traffic for approximately one month beginning on Friday, May 7. Traffic should follow the posted detour during this time.

Work on County Road 96 between County Road 23 and Trunk Highway 3 continues.

### WHAT SHOULD I EXPECT?

County Road 23 is scheduled to close to traffic for approximately one month beginning on Friday, May 7. The road will be closed from approximately 0.25 miles west of Eveleth Avenue to approximately 0.25 miles south of 320<sup>th</sup> Street. This full closure is necessary to reconstruct and realign the intersection. Please see the map on the back of this sheet for detour information.

County Road 96 between County Road 23 and Trunk Highway 3 will remain closed to thru traffic as grading continues.

Access to residences will remain open from the east end of the project.
