County Board of Commissioners Meeting Dakota County, Minnesota April 20, 2010

The Dakota County Board of Commissioners met on April 20, 2010 and took action with respect to the following matters:

Acceptance: Resignation from member of Community Development Agency Board

Adoption: Revisions to Hastings Judicial Center Point-of-Entry Screening Policy

Appointments: Human Services Advisory Committee - Fardosa Hassan; Farmland and Natural Areas Program Advisory Committee - Todd Kruse; and Community Development Agency Board – Commissioner Willis E. Branning

Approvals: April 6, 2010 County Board Minutes; Model Joint Powers Agreement for enforcement of township ordinances; 2010 Dakota County Emergency Response Plan for Prairie Island Nuclear Generating Plant; and 3.2% Malt Beverage Licenses applications from MN Scottish Fair & Highland Games, Bellwood Oaks, Inc., USW Local 662, and Woody's Pump N Munch, Inc.
