

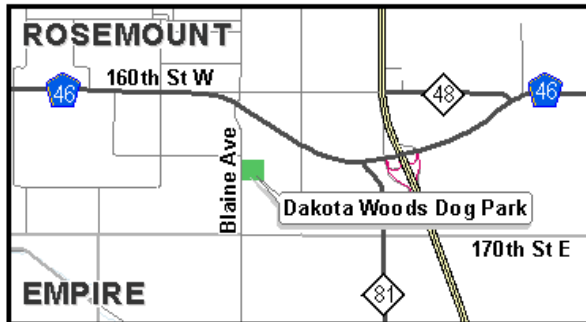

Welcome to Dakota Woods Dog Park!

The Dakota Woods Dog Park is a 16-acre, fenced site that provides ample space for dogs to exercise off leash. There is no surface water in the park.

The site is composed primarily of mixed woods with three acres of open space. A dog walking trail loop connects the wooded trail to the open space.

OPEN DAILY: 5 AM to 10 PM

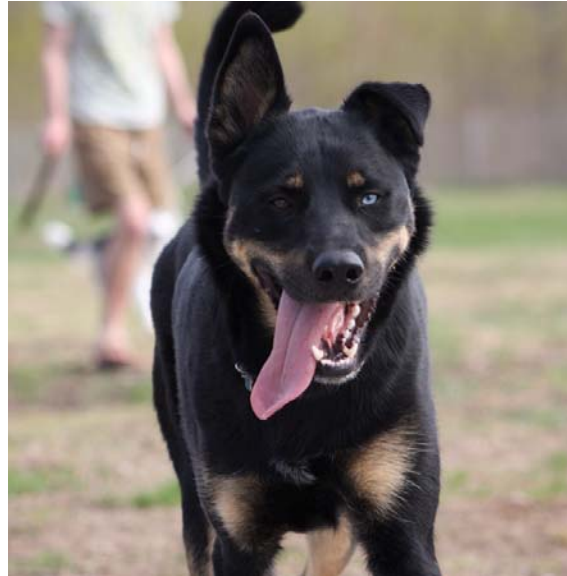
PASS REQUIRED

Only those dog owners who have purchased a pass can exercise their dogs in this area.

Daily passes are available at the onsite pay box.

FEES:

Daily Pass: \$5
Annual Pass: \$42.85 (\$40 + tax)



Park Amenities:

Wooded and open areas

Dakota Woods Dog Park Rules:

- Always purchase and display a pass prior to using the Dog Park.
- Bring ample water for your dog.
- Dogs must be kept under direct control of their handler at all times.
- Two dog per handler limit.
- Children under the age of 15 must be supervised.
- Food and dog toys are not allowed.
- Be courteous to other dog handlers—monitor dogs playing together.
- Dogs must be on a leash prior to entering and upon exiting the Dog Park.
- Animal cruelty is not allowed—do not punish other dogs.
- Handler must be present in the Dog Park area with their dog(s) at all times.
- Handler must have a leash available and visible for use at all times.
- Handler must clean up all pet waste.
- All dogs must be properly licensed and vaccinated and display a valid tags.
- All dogs must be over four months of age.
- Dogs in heat are not allowed.
- Handlers are liable for any damage or injury inflicted by their dog.
- Dakota County Parks are smoke-free. Smoking is prohibited inside the Dog Park.
- Handler must abide by all other park rules and Park Ordinance 107.
- Dogs declared dangerous are not allowed.
- Firearms are not allowed.
