ANNUAL OVERSIZE APPLICATION

A copy of this permit must be kept with the vehicle at all times and displayed upon demand by any peace officer or officers of Dakota County. This permit will become void and subject to confiscation for any misuse. All Minnesota Statutes and Department of Public Safety Regulations must be complied with. Dakota County issues this permit to be oversized, but does not guarantee the clearances needed for your load – you must inspect your route. Permission is granted for the below vehicle movement under the Minnesota Highway Traffic regulations act, subject to the following special requirements:

This vehicle is permitted to carry loads 14'6" wide, 14'0" high, 95' long, and be under the posted weight limit per axle. Vehicles exceeding posted limits during restriction periods are not authorized.

In the event of breakdown, vehicles and equipment should be moved off the highway, if not possible to do so immediately, flags, flares, lights or reflectors shall be placed as required by law. The Dakota County Sheriff's office or the local Police, shall be notified if the load and vehicle cannot be immediately moved off the highway.

Hours of oversize vehicle movement - Mon.- Fri. permitted travel from 12:01am to 10:00pm, Fridays between Memorial Day to Labor Day and/or the day before a Holiday from 12:01 a.m. to 2:00p.m., Saturdays and Sundays from 12:01 a.m. to 10:00 p.m.. No Holiday or Holiday weekend travel.

Rush hour movement – No movement over 12 foot, 6 inches wide in the Cities of Lakeville, Farmington, Burnsville, Apple Valley, Rosemount, Eagan, Inver Grove Heights, Hastings, Mendota, Mendota Heights, Sunfish Lake, West St. Paul, and South St. Paul between the hours of 6:00 a.m. - 8:30 a.m. or 3:30 p.m. - 6:00 p.m. Monday – Friday. No rush hour restriction on Saturday or Sunday.

The permittee is responsible for all liability for personal injury, property damage, or time lost, which may occur in relation to the movement and in the event any claim is made against the County of Dakota, or any Department, Division Officer or employee thereof through, by reason of or in connection with any act or omission, permittee shall defend, indemnify and hold them harmless from any claim. In accepting this permit, the permittee agrees to repair at his (their) expense and to the satisfaction of the Dakota County Highway Engineer any damage to highways, signs or structures. Repairs may be done by Highway Department forces at the option of said Department and the cost of such work to be borne by permittee
