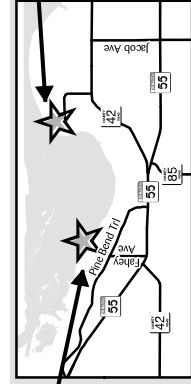
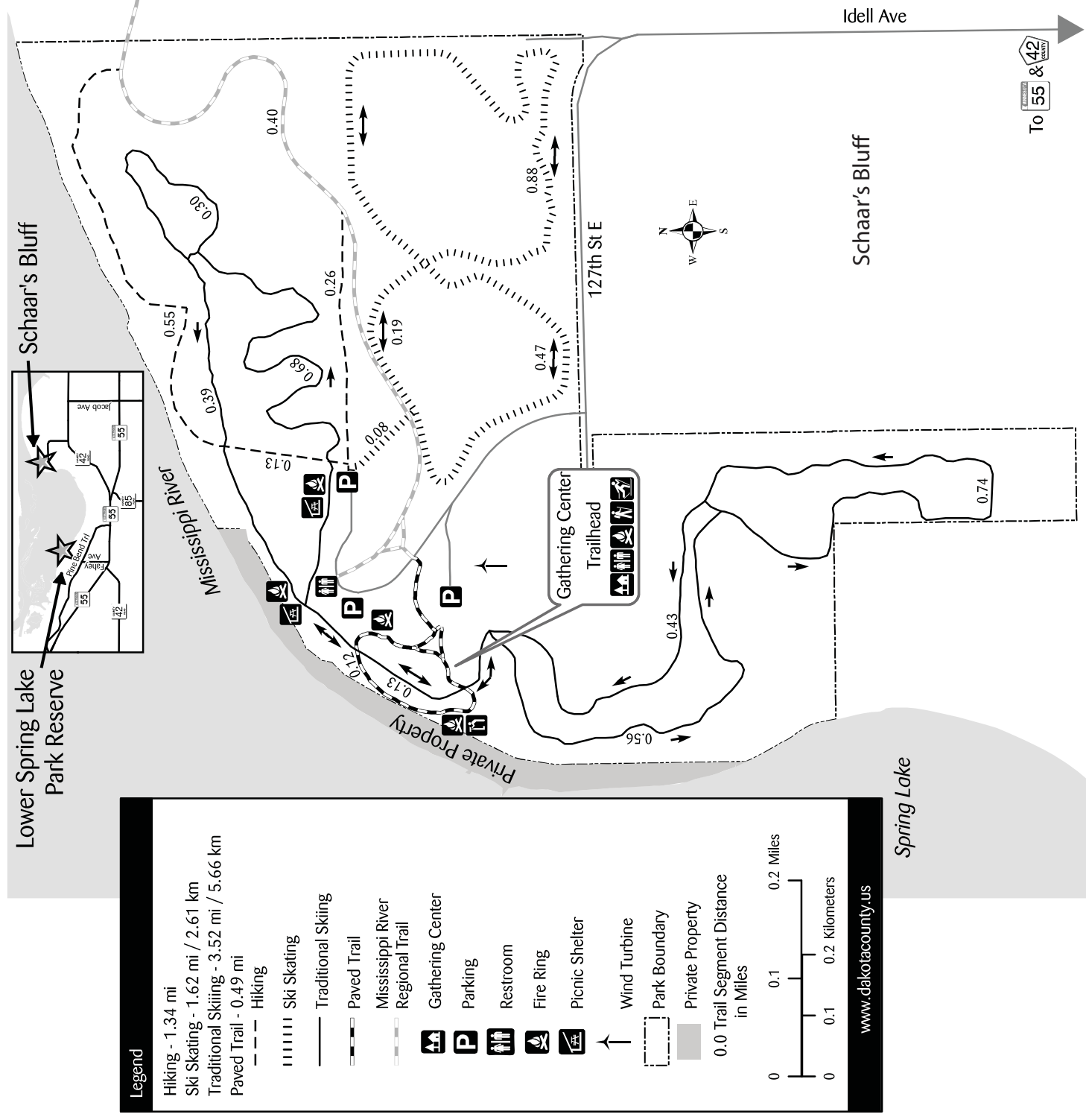

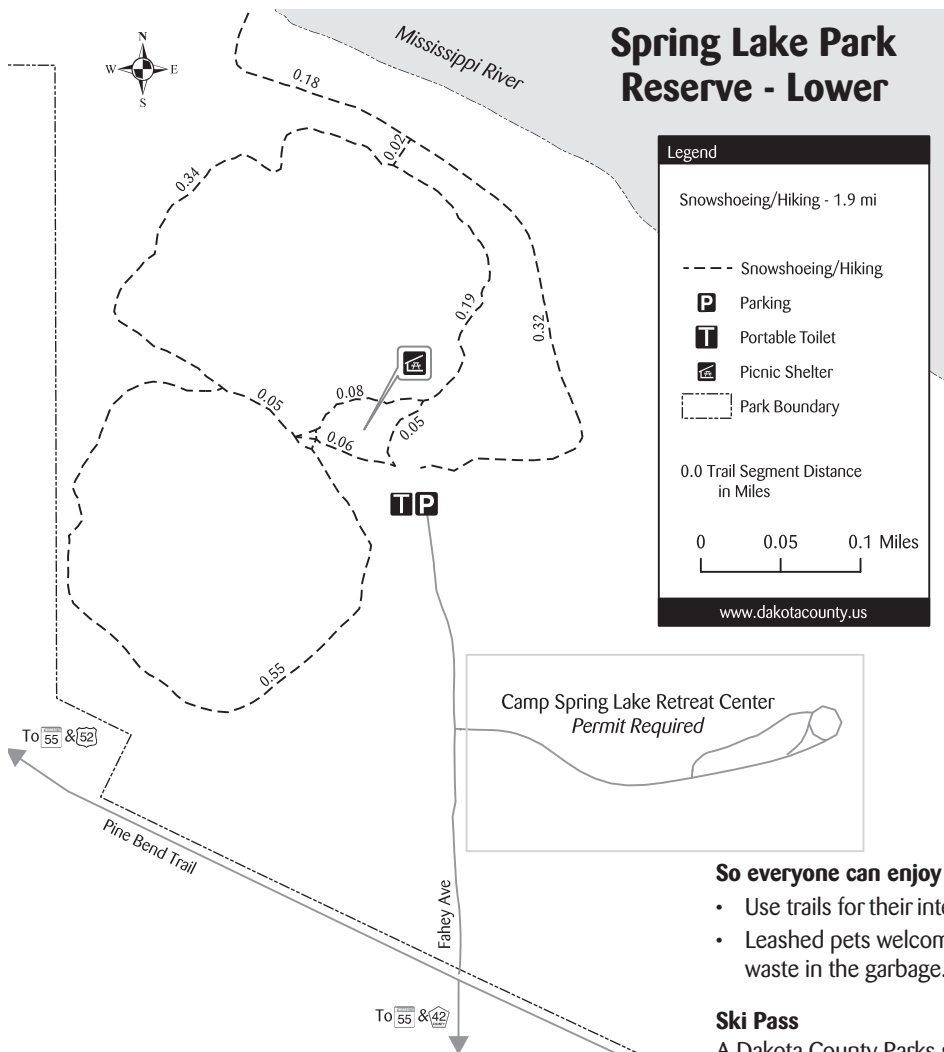

Spring Lake Park Reserve

Welcome to Spring Lake Park Reserve. This park is a rest stop along the 3,000-mile Great River Road and offers miles of blufftop trails with a birds-eye view of the Mississippi River.

Spring Lake Park Reserve is part of the Dakota County Park System.

Admission and parking are free.

Features

- 5.3 miles of groomed trails for traditional skiing and ski-skating
- 3 miles of nature trails for hiking and snowshoeing
- 0.5 miles of paved trail
- Scenic overlooks

- Use trails for their intended purpose.
- Leashed pets welcome on non-ski trails. Please put pet waste in the garbage.

Ski Pass
