Vaccinations Available through Dakota County Public Health Department

The Dakota County Public Health Department receives some vaccines from federal and state programs and offers those vaccines at low cost to children and adults who meet program eligibility guidelines (see below). The suggested cost for each vaccination is \$14.00, but no one who qualifies for the low cost vaccinations will be turned away if they are unable to pay.

CHILDREN:

Low cost vaccinations for children (18 years of age and younger) may be available through the Minnesota Vaccines for Children (MnVFC) Program for:

- Children who **do not** have health insurance
- Children on a Minnesota Health Care Program - MA, MnCare, or PMAP (bring your medical card)
- Children who are American Indian or Alaskan Native
- Children who have health insurance that does not cover vaccinations
- Children who have health insurance with an **unmet** deductible or who have exceeded their annual cap

ADULTS:

Low cost vaccinations for adults (19 years of age and older) may be available through the Uninsured and Underinsured Adult Vaccine (UUAV) Program for:

- Adults who **do not** have health insurance
- Adults who have health insurance that does not cover vaccinations
- Adults who have health insurance with an **unmet** deductible or who have exceeded their annual cap
