Eligible Recipients	 Local Government Units (Cities, Townships, school districts, WMOs) Lake Associations
Examples of Projects	 Education and Outreach Early Detection and Population Assessment Watercraft Inspection and Decontamination Management of New or Established AIS Populations Law Enforcement
Application Timeline	Applications are due March 22nd, 2021
Funding Potential	Proposals may receive full or partial funding based on number of funding requests and application ranking
Matching Funds	Matching funds are preferred, but not required
Project Timeline	Project activities must be completed by December 1st, 2021
Reporting Requirements	 Each project must enter into a formal project contract/agreement with the County addressing conditions of the award A report summarizing work completed with invoices for grant reimbursement is due December 15th, 2021
