

O PROJECT BACKGROUND:

The Vermillion Highlands Greenway Project in Rosemount is part of a larger 11-mile greenway that will travel through downtown Rosemount, the Dakota County Technical College campus, and the University of Minnesota's UMORE property. The greenway will connect with the Vermillion River Greenway, the Rosemount Greenway and the greenway hub at Lebanon Hills Regional Park.

This greenway will help renew the area and connect community members with safe travel between key destinations.



PROJECT OBJECTIVES:

This project will ultimately identify a preferred trail alignment and tunnel crossing at County Road 42 while:

- Finding opportunities to improve the safety and accessibility of trail crossings
- Adding connections to local trails and sidewalks
