

Dodd Boulevard at Lake Marion Greenway Trail



Improvement Need.

Low yield compliance for people crossing Dodd Boulevard at the existing marked crosswalk.

Area Where Applicable.

- Trail crossings or locations with a high number of pedestrians and bicyclists crossing.
- RRFBs are context specific and their effectivness varies depending upon the type of roadway, number of lanes, traffic volumes, and speeds.

Proposed Temporary Improvements.

- Rectangular Rapid Flashing Beacons (RRFBs)
- Advanced pedestrian crossing signage
- Refresh crosswalk markings

Other Considerations.

- RRFBs have been shown to reduce pedestrian crashes by up to 47 percent per the FHWA.
- A Federal Highway Administration (FHWA) study showed that yield compliance increased from 0-26 percent to 72-96 percent with the addition of RRFBs following two years of use.
