

## Lake Byllesby Regional Park

Welcome to Lake Byllesby Regional Park. This park is a great recreation destination with hiking trails that meander through savannas and prairies along the shores of Lake Byllesby, the largest lake in southern Dakota County.

Lake Byllesby Regional Park is part of the Dakota County Park System.

Admission and parking are free.

### Park features

- 3+ miles of packed, multi-use winter trails for snowshoeing, winter hiking, skijoring/dogsledding and skate skiing
- 1+ miles of cleared paved winter hiking trails
- Access to Lake Byllesby for ice fishing
- Mill Towns State Trail access

### So everyone can enjoy the park...

- Use trails for their intended purpose.
- Leashed pets are welcome. Please put pet waste in the garbage.

### Cross-country ski pass

A Dakota County Parks ski pass is required for skiers/skijors/dog sledders age 18 and older. Passes are only available online at [www.dakotacounty.us/parks](http://www.dakotacounty.us/parks), search *ski pass*, or in person at the Lebanon Hills Visitor Center. Daily passes are \$6 and season passes are \$25. There are no pay boxes at trailheads.
