FOR YOUR ORGANIZATION

Sign up to receive a text and email from the Dakota County Community Agency Alert Network (CAAN) about urgent public health situations affecting your community – like extreme heat, poor air quality, infectious disease and more.

WHY SHOULD I SIGN UP?

It is important to have accurate and timely information about public health situations that may impact the well-being of your community.

Your organization can receive alerts with actionable guidance to help individuals and agencies stay safe during urgent events such as:

- Extreme weather
- Disease outbreaks
- Air quality advisories
- Other health related concerns

WHO SHOULD SIGN UP?

Sign up if your organization provides services for people or groups who are especially vulnerable during urgent public health events, especially those who:

- Have language barriers
- Have cognitive or physical disabilities
- Are low income or homeless
- Are deaf or hard of hearing
- Are older adults or young children

We recommend that more than one person from your organization sign up.
