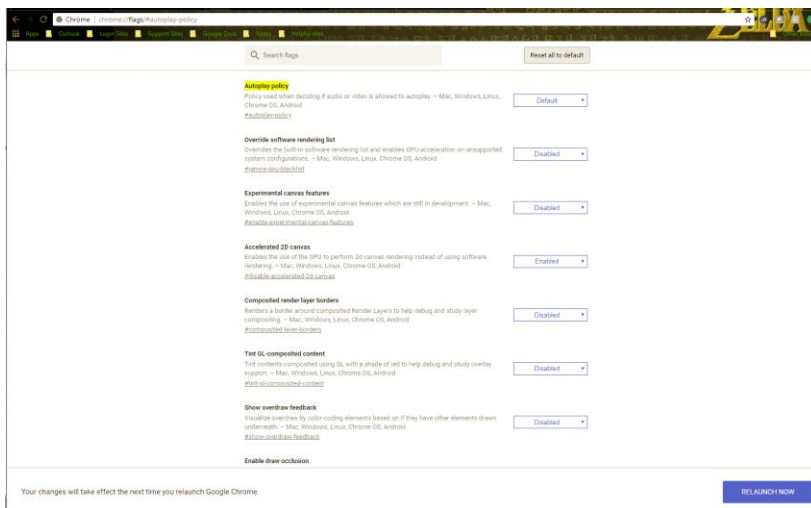


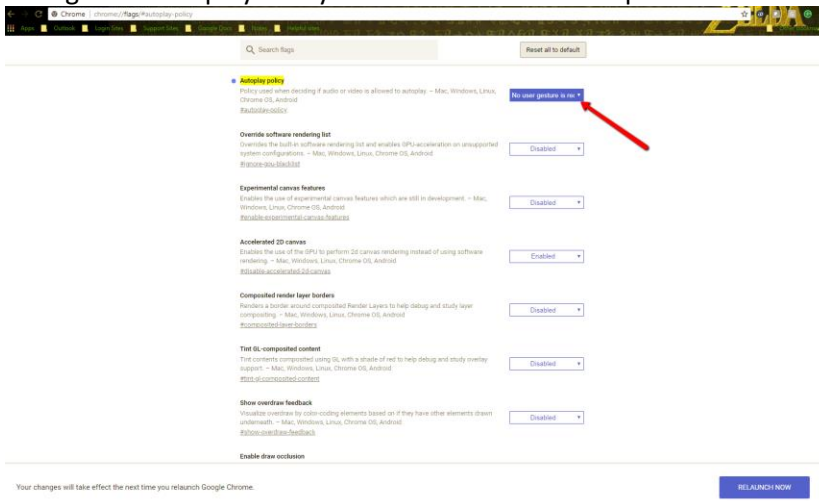
# How To Disable Autoplay Blocker in Chrome

Chrome has a new feature that blocks content with audio that plays automatically, in order to view your Granicus Content you'll need to perform the following steps.

1. Copy and paste **chrome://flags/#autoplay-policy** in your chrome browser URL bar and hit enter.



2. Change the Autoplay Policy to “No User Gesture Required”



3. Click Relaunch Now to relaunch your browser and apply the change.

- Autoplay policy**  
Policy used when deciding if audio or video is allowed to autoplay. - Mac, Windows, Linux, Chrome OS, Android  
[#autoplay-policy](#) No user gesture is req.
- Override software rendering list**  
Overrides the built-in software rendering list and enables GPU acceleration on unsupported system configurations. - Mac, Windows, Linux, Chrome OS, Android  
[#override-software-rendering](#) Disabled
- Experimental canvas features**  
Enables the use of experimental canvas features which are still in development. - Mac, Windows, Linux, Chrome OS, Android  
[#enable-experimental-canvas-features](#) Disabled
- Accelerated 2D canvas**  
Enables the use of the GPU to perform 2D canvas rendering instead of using software rendering. - Mac, Windows, Linux, Chrome OS, Android  
[#use-the-accelerated-2d-canvas](#) Enabled
- Composited render layer borders**  
Renders a border around composited Render Layers to help debug and study layer compositing. - Mac, Windows, Linux, Chrome OS, Android  
[#composited-layer-borders](#) Disabled
- Hint OI-composited content**  
Hints contents composited using OI, with a shade of red to help debug and study overlay support. - Mac, Windows, Linux, Chrome OS, Android  
[#OI-composited-content](#) Disabled
- Show overlay feedback**  
Visualizes overlays by color coding elements based on if they have other elements drawn underneath. - Mac, Windows, Linux, Chrome OS, Android  
[#show-overlay-feedback](#) Disabled
- Enable draw occlusion**
