

# Criminal Justice Network Joint Powers Agreement

August 10, 2021

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#### Purpose



Request Board Consideration of Criminal Justice Network (CJN) Joint Powers Agreement which transitions CJN services, including Records Management System (RMS) and CJN Operations from a County department to an independent Joint Powers Organization (JPO).

#### CJN Overview



#### **CJN History:**

- 2001 2005 CJN project supported by grants
- 2006 CJN became County department

**CJN Purpose:** Use the latest technology to make information sharing and integration easier through automating and consolidating forms, leveraging knowledge, dollars and resources by promoting conversation, discussion, and information sharing across jurisdictional boundaries. CJN makes timely, accurate, and relevant information available to the police officers, prosecutors, judges, probation officers and even social service providers who work together to make our communities safer.

**Membership:** 9 of 13 Dakota County Public Safety Organizations (includes Sheriff)

## Negotiating approach



Negotiations subgroup with members. Membership:

- 2 member Police Chiefs,
- 2 member City manager/administrators
- Sheriff
- County Attorney

#### Purpose:

Negotiate, with County Administration, proposal for transition of CJN to an independent JPO with limited term County financial support and provision of in-kind services



	JPA Elements
Term	5 years
County Subsidy	Years 1 – 5 \$472,642 annually
Fund Balance Allocation	Entire RMS and Operations FB to JPO (2020 \$1,157,014)
Governance	CJN Board of Directors will be comprised of: (1) the police chief of each member city (or his/her designee); the Dakota County Sheriff (or his/her designee); and one member appointed by the Dakota County Board of Commissioners for the initial 5-year term of the JPA
County In-Kind Services	Years 1 – 5: Payroll, Benefits Administration, Legal Services. Years 1-2: Fiscal Agent, IT Desktop Support, Risk Management assistance with insurances Year 1: Employee Relations (SuccessFactors and Learning Management System)

 Approve Joint Powers Agreement effective January 1, 2022

- Development of contracts for in-kind services to take effect January 1, 2022
