There is 1 legal aid attorney for every 3,000 Minnesotans in need of legal help. County law libraries help bridge this gap by making legal information accessible to everyone.



County law libraries provide free access to legal resources, clinics, and self-help materials. We are open to the public and serve everyone.



CLLs are usually located in the courthouse, so attorneys and the public can access resources at the point of need.

MN Statutes Chapter 134A County Law Libraries



Minn. Stat. § 134A.10 subd. 4 states that "the law library board of trustees shall, with the approval of the board of commissioners, set the amount of the law library fee for civil and criminal matters..."

History of costs and revenue 2015-2020






