Installing Microsoft AlwaysOn (MSAO) VPN

This document will walk staff through installing Microsoft AlwaysOn VPN on their county-issued laptop.

Notes about use of Microsoft AlwaysOn VPN:

- Users must be connecting with a county-owned laptop.
- Users must be enrolled in multi-factor authentication (MFA) and use the Microsoft Authenticator mobile app for notifications (MSAO will not accept an MFA text code). <u>User Guide: Enroll in Multifactor Authentication (MFA)</u>
- Users needing to connect to the criminal justice network are not able to use MSAO.

INSTRUCTIONS

- 1. Laptop must be connected to the County network in a County building or through Cisco VPN.
- 2. Click on the Windows icon in the lower left corner, type in *Software Center* and open the **Software Center** application.



- 3. When the Software Center opens:
 - A. Type "alwayson" in the search bar and hit enter.
 - B. The AlwaysOn VPN AlwaysOn VPN with CERT application will appear for you to click to open.

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4. Click the **Install** button for AlwaysOnVPN to be installed on your laptop. This process may take a few minutes.
