<b>AWARE</b>	Reduced rate Taxi rides for individuals who are COVID-19 positive or have symptoms to go to medical care or to COVID-19 testing sites. Call Metro Mobility (MM) for MM eligible riders or Transit Link at 651-602-LINK for those who are not MM eligible. You must state that you have tested positive or have COVID-19 symptoms
<b>DARTS Loops</b>	<a href="#">Loop schedules</a> are currently operational, but being revised. Loop services are available in South St. Paul, West St. Paul, Lakeville and Hastings. Farmington loop to Lakeville Cub is also available.
<b>DARTS Individuals Rides</b>	Personalized Door to Door transportation is available for free or at a sliding scale. Call 651-455-1560 to set up a ride.
<b>GAPP Services – Volunteer Driver Program</b>	Free rides to life-sustaining medical appointments. Call 952-953-9299
