With that, the EMS Advisory Council announces its inaugural **Post High School EMS Education Scholarship**. The council will award two \$500 scholarships to Dakota County High school seniors that intent to pursue post high school EMS or other healthcare related education. Scholarship funds may be applied towards reimbursement of tuition and other related fees for an accredited education program.

Interested applicants must be a graduating high school senior and have attended a Dakota County high school or reside within a Dakota County high school district. Applicants should submit their completed application package to the Council no later than March 31, 2024. Council scholarship committee members will review all applications and will provide an award recommendation to the executive committee prior to the Spring 2024 meeting.

Winning applicants will be recognized at the annual Dakota County EMS Award and Recognition Luncheon.
