Lifeline

- Lifeline benefits
- Who: enrolled in one of the following: SNAP, Medicaid, Federal Public Housing Assistance, SSI, Veterans and Survivors Pension Benefit, or certain Tribal Programs.
- Savings: Eligible families can get up to \$9.25 off the cost of phone, internet, or bundled services

Museums

Bell Museum

- Museums for All
- Where: Bell Museum, St. Paul, MN. The Bell Museum is a natural history museum.
- Who: Enrolled in one of the following: TANF, MFIP, SNAP, General Assistance, Medical Assistance, MinnesotaCare, WIC, SSI, Social Security Disability Benefits, SNAP, Section 8 Housing, Free/Reduced Price School Meals
- Cost: free admission to museum, \$3 tickets to planetarium, \$15 Curiosity Membership for 1 year; waived admission for all Indigenous peoples

Minnesota Children's Museum

- All Play Program
- Where: Children's Museum, St. Paul, MN
- Who: Families receiving benefits through EBT, WIC, or National School Lunch Program
- Cost: discounted admission- \$3 per person, or an annual membership for \$39; Bring: Proof of eligibility

Minnesota Historical Society

- History Connects program
- Where: Minnesota History Center, St. Paul, MN; Mill City Museum, Minneapolis, MN; Historic Fort Snelling,
 St. Paul MN
- Who: enrolled in one of the following: TANF, MFIP, WIC, General Assistance, Medical Assistance, MinnesotaCare, SSI, Social Security Disability Benefits, SNAP, Section 8 Housing, Free/Reduced Price School Meals
- Cost: \$4 admission for adults, free for children 17 and under
- Bring: this form completed, photo ID, and proof of program eligibility

- Who: Enrolled in one of the following: TANF, MFIP, WIC, General Assistance, Medical Assistance, MinnesotaCare, SSI, Social Security Disability Benefits, SNAP, Section 8 Housing, Free/Reduced Price School Meals
- Cost: \$3 daily museum admission rate, \$3 Omnitheater admission rate

The Works Museum

- Gateway program
- Where: The Works Museum, Bloomington, MN. The Works is a hands-on kids museum all about engineering.
- Who: Enrolled in one of the following programs: Free/reduced price lunch, SNAP, TANF, MFIP, WIC, SSI, Section 8 Housing, Medical Assistance/Medicaid Care/Minnesota Care, Basic Sliding Fee Childcare Assistance
- Cost: \$6.50 per person discounted daily admission price or \$25 family membership
- Bring: physical proof of eligibility

- Cost: Free admission with optional donation

- Who: families who qualify for Free/Reduced School Lunch household income guidelines
- Cost: \$5 tickets to performances and Theatre Arts Training scholarships
- Apply online

Guthrie Theater

- Gateway Ticket program
- Where: Guthrie Theater, Minneapolis, MN
- Who: enrolled in one of the following: TANF, MFIP, WIC, General Assistance, Medical Assistance, MinnesotaCare, SSI, Social Security Disability Benefits, SNAP, Section 8 Housing
- Cost: \$5 tickets to performances

Stages Theatre

- Open Door program & Pay What You Can performances
- Where: Stages Theater, Hopkins, MN
- Who: need/income-based, families can apply online
- Cost: free and reduced cost tickets, bus subsidies, and tuition assistance
- Pay What You Can performances: one performance offered for each production. No minimum price. Reserve your tickets 30 days in advance.

Transportation

Metro Transit

- Transit Access Program (TAP)
- Where: all around the Twin Cities Metro
- Who: enrolled in one of the following: SNAP, WIC, Energy Assistance, General Assistance, MFIP, Minnesota Unemployment Insurance (UI) Program, Refugee Certification, Diversionary Work Program, Medical Assistance/MinnesotaCare
- Cost: \$1 fare, even during rush hour
- Apply online or in person at one of the transit facilities

 Cost: Free admission with optional donation

Minnesota Zoo

- Free to Explore program
- Where: Minnesota Zoo, Apple Valley, MN
- Who: Enrolled in one of the following programs: TANF, MFIP, SNAP, MFAP, General Assistance (GA), MSA, Medical Assistance/Minnesota Care, WIC, Head Start, FDPIR, Housing Support, Resident Disabled Veterans
- Cost: free admission
- Bring: Approved documentation, photo identification and proof of Minnesota residency
- Other: Parking and other fees are not included. Reserve your tickets online before going.
