
#### ADDRESS OF HOUSE HOW TO FIND

A) HOUSE LOCATED ON NORTH & SOUTH STREETS EXAMPLE: ADDRESS OF - 30400 ISLE AVE


HOUSE NUMBERS SHOWN ON LEFT SIDE OF MAP 300 TH ST. 30000----LINE. 310 TH ST. 31000----STREET NAMES SHOWN ON BOTTOM OF MAP

THIS HOUSE IS ON ISLE AVENUE WITH HOUSE NO. 30400 IT IS 30.4 MILES SOUTH OF BASE LINE OR 0.4 MILE SOUTH OF 300 TH ST. ISLE IS 9 TH LETTER OF THE ALPHABET; THEREFORE, HOUSE IS MORE THAN 8 MILES FROM DIVISION

B) HOUSE LOCATED ON EAST & WEST STREETS




## SUGGESTED MAIL BOX INSTALLATION



WHENEVER POSSIBLE BOXES MUST BE LOCATED SO THAT CARRIER'S VEHICLE IS OFF PAVEMENT WHEN SERVING THEM.

NAME AND BOX NUMBER MUST BE PAINTED ON BOX NOT LESS THAN ONE INCH HIGH. POST MUST BE NEAT AND OF ADEQUATE STRENGTH AND SIZE.

APPROACH TO BOX SHOULD BE A HARD LEVEL SURFACE (GRAVEL, CINDERS, STONE). LOCATE BOX BEYOND END OF POST. ATTACH BOARD HOLDING BOX TO POST WITH SCREWS OR DOUBLEHEADED NAILS, PERMITTING EASY REMOVAL IF NECESSARY TO ADJUST



### MOST ACCIDENTS ARE CAUSED BY THE DRIVER

BOX HEIGHT.

FOUR COMMON ACCIDENT CAUSES ARE:

- I. THE DRIVER DIDN'T THINK
- 2. HE DIDN'T LOOK
- 3. HE DIDN'T KNOW 4. HE DIDN'T CARE

TO KEEP OUT OF ACCIDENTS AVOID DISTRACTION, HIGH SPEED, TAKING CHANCES, DRIVING AFTER DRINKING AND FATIGUE. WATCH OUT FOR PEDESTRIANS. BE DOUBLY CAREFUL AFTER DARK.

#### SAFETY BELTS SAVE LIVES
