PERMITTED WEIGHT LIMIT IS NOT VALID DURING SEASONAL WEIGHT RESTRICTIONS – SEPARATE PERMITS ARE REQUIRED.

The vehicle may be permitted to carry loads 14'6" wide, 14'0" high, 95' long and be under the restricted weight limit per axle up to 180,000 lbs. total gross weight. Permittee agrees to reimburse Dakota County for all damages done to the highway, signs or structures as a result of the permittee's moving operations.

All MN Statutes, MNDOT / Dakota County General Conditions for Oversize/Overweight Loads and Department of Public Safety Regulations must be complied with. Dakota County issues the permit to be oversize, but does not guarantee the clearances needed for your load – you must inspect your route. MNDOT has approved bridge crossings without a separate state permit for legally spaced axle weights for 9 & 10 ton axle weight limits on Dakota County highways, with up to a maximum of 220,000 lbs. total vehicle weight. The permit may grant permission for the above vehicle on a Dakota County highway under the Minnesota Highway Traffic regulations act, subject to the following special requirements:

24 - Hour movement is allowed by permit for loads that are overweight, over height, up to 14.6' wide except for Holiday and Rush Hour movement restrictions.

Holiday movement: No travel over 10' wide and/or 110' long, is allowed from 2:00 P.M. the day before until 2:00 A.M. the day after the following holidays: New Year's Day, Memorial Day, Independence Day, Labor Day, Thanksgiving and Christmas Day.

Rush hour movement: No movement over 12'6" wide in the cities of Lakeville, Farmington, Burnsville, Apple Valley, Rosemount, Eagan, Inver Grove Heights, Hastings, Mendota, Mendota Heights, Sunfish Lake, West St. Paul or South St. Paul between the hours of 6:00a.m. - 8:30a.m. or 3:30p.m. - 6:00p.m. Monday - Friday. No rush hour restrictions on Saturdays or Sundays.

Other Restrictions: 14.6' to 16' wide are allowed Daytime movement on multi-lane (divided) Highways. Undivided and two lane roadways are only allowed Midnight to 5:00 A.M. Over 16' wide anywhere is only allowed Midnight to 5:00 A.M.

The permittee is responsible for all liability for personal injury, property damage or time lost, which may occur in relation to the movement and in the event any claim is made against the County of Dakota, or any Department, Division Office or employee thereof through, by reason of or in connection with any act or omission, permittee shall defend, indemnify and hold them harmless from any claim. In accepting the permit, the permittee agrees to repair at their expense and to the satisfaction of the Dakota County Highway Engineer any damage to Highways, signs or structures. Repairs may be done by Highway Department forces at the option of said Department and the cost of such work to be borne by permittee. The permittee is responsible for all liability and shall defend, indemnify and hold Dakota County and it's employees harmless from any claims related to movement under the permit.

Dakota County Highway Restrictions:

- 1) During Spring Load Restrictions
- 2) County Road 81 from CSAH 66 to TH 50 north of Hampton (posted 7 ton)

MNDOT Bridge Weight Restrictions:

If over GVW > 136,000 lbs., contact MNDOT Bridge Office for approval over the following:

- 1) Bridge over US 52 at Dakota County Highway 88 in Randolph Township.
- 2) Bridge over I35W at 195th St. in Lakeville.
