



# CONSTRUCTION UPDATE

## County Road 42 and Akron Avenue, Rosemount

March 25, 2021

Thank you for your patience while we make important improvements to increase safety and improve traffic flow.

### WHAT'S BEING DONE?

Dakota County, in cooperation with the City of Rosemount will install a traffic signal with overhead lighting at the intersection of County Road 42 and Akron Avenue (County Road 73 to the north). The project includes widening Akron Avenue south of County Road 42 to align the roadway with the north side of Akron Avenue as well as median changes along County Road 42 from east of Akron Avenue to Audrey Avenue. These median changes will include ¾ turns at the two Dakota County Technical College entrances.

### WHEN WILL WORK TAKE PLACE?

Construction is scheduled to begin on Monday, March 29th. Work on the project will wrap up in October 2021. Private utilities (electric, telephone, cable, etc.) will be relocating some of their facilities throughout project limits as well.

### WHAT SHOULD I EXPECT?

Work will begin with tree removal, as necessary, and installation of erosion control devices. Removal of pavement, striping of topsoil and remove and install new storm sewer and installing the signal and lighting and then paving and striping will follow. One lane of eastbound County Road 42 will be closed for an extended period of time for construction work.
