



CONSTRUCTION UPDATE

County Road 78, Castle Rock Township

April 30, 2020

Thank you for your patience while we make important improvements to increase safety and improve traffic flow.

WHAT'S BEING DONE?

County Road 78 (240th Street W/Alverno Avenue/245th St W) from Trunk Highway 3 (Chippendale Avenue) to County Road 79 (Blaine Avenue). The reconstruction project will add paved roadway surface and shoulders, turn lanes or bypass lanes at intersections, and improve drainage with proper culvert sizing. The project also includes the construction of a wetland basin adjacent to CSAH 78 for nitrate treatment.

WHEN WILL WORK TAKE PLACE?

Private utility companies will start relocating their facilities. In addition, tree removal as necessary and installation of erosion control devices will occur.

Road work is scheduled to begin on Tuesday, May 12th and will continue through late fall.

WHAT SHOULD I EXPECT?

Work on the roadway will progress from west to east, tentatively, and consist of grading, pipe and culvert installation, paving, and restoration of areas disturbed by construction.

County Road 78 will be closed to traffic through late fall beginning on Tuesday, May 12th. Access to residences will remain open throughout construction; however, access may be limited to only one direction.
