



## Construction Update – Cliff Road (County Road 32), Eagan

### What's Being Done?

Cliff Road (County Road 32) from Lexington Avenue (County Road 43) to 0.2 miles east of Dodd Road in Eagan will be reconstructed. The project will reconstruct Cliff Road into a two-lane divided roadway utilizing a raised center median, 8-foot shoulders, curb and gutter and 10-foot shared use trails on each side of the roadway.

### When Will Work Take Place?

Private utility companies will start relocating their facilities as soon as feasible. In addition, tree removal will start along the corridor.

Road work is scheduled to begin in the spring when the road restrictions are lifted.

### What Should I Expect?

The reconstruction will include: turn lanes at public intersection, a signal modification at Lexington Avenue (County Road 43), a roundabout at the intersection of Cliff Road and Dodd Road, drainage improvements and retaining walls along the roadway.
