

PROJECT LOCATION


Lexington Avenue (County Road 43) between


Long-Term Intersection Concept — Northview Park Road



Benefits of a Roundabout Intersection

- Promote traffic calming
- Promote lower speeds
- Eliminate right angle crashes
- Improve intersection operations
- Reduce conflict points
- Improved pedestrian crossings and safety

WHAT TO EXPECT

Construction Work Hours

- Typically 7AM to 7PM Monday through Saturday
- Some evening and limited Sunday work will occur



Trail Access

Trail traffic will be diverted to the opposite side of the road during trail grading and paving and pedestrian ramp construction



Dust

Sweeping and water trucks will be used to minimize dust from work areas



Restrictions

- Most work will be performed maintaining traffic in both directions
- Flaggers will be present at times to direct traffic
- Westbound Diffley Road traffic (west of Lexington Avenue) will be detoured during one weekend for storm sewer construction
- Vehicle traffic will be allowed on the milled roadway surface prior to paving
- The traffic signal at the Lexington Avenue / Diffley Road intersection will remain operational at all times
