

Construction Update – 2023 Dakota County Overlay & Misc. Projects

What's Being Done?

Dakota County will rehabilitate approximately 16.85 miles of pavement as part of the overlay contract this construction season. Pavement rehabilitation of the driving lanes and shoulders of the roadways involve grinding off a layer of asphalt and replacing it with new material. This is typically referred to as a "mill and overlay". The end product will be better looking, longer lasting and smoother roadway.

However, more than just pavement will be rehabilitated this season. Other work will include miscellaneous concrete work and minor utility adjustments and improvements. Improvements will be made to some of the signal systems. The parking lots at the Dakota County Administrative Center in Hastings, the access road to Lebanon Hills and Camp Sacajawea, parking lot at Thompson Park, and numerous trails will also be resurfaced.

When Will Work Take Place?

The pedestrian curb ramp improvements, utility repairs, signal revisions, and milling and overlay construction on County Road 5 from the I-35 southbound ramps to County Road 46 (162nd Street W) in Lakeville are scheduled to begin September 5th, 2023.

What Should I Expect?

Drivers should expect temporary lane closures, flaggers, and delays throughout the project. Please allow extra time for travel, watch for construction signage and be cautious while driving through the construction area.
