

Construction Update – 2023 Dakota County Overlay & Misc. Projects

What's Being Done?

Dakota County will rehabilitate approximately 16.85 miles of pavement as part of the overlay contract this construction season. Part of the project involves reclaiming and repaving some trails. The trail along County Road 5 from County Road 46 to 150th Street is included in the project.

Other work on this project may include miscellaneous concrete work and minor utility adjustments and improvements.

When Will Work Take Place?

Construction on County Road 5 from 162nd Street W (County Road 46) to 150th Street W in Burnsville and Lakeville is scheduled to begin July 13th, 2023. The start of the project will include trail reclamation followed by paving work that is expected to last a week.

What Should I Expect?

Although most of the work will take place off the road, drivers should expect temporary lane closures, flaggers, and possible delays throughout the project. Please allow extra time for travel, watch for construction signage and be cautious while driving through the construction area.
