

## MAILBOXES

# Suggested Installation of a Single Box




#### Suggested Installation Where Snow Removal is a Problem



Extend box beyond end of post. Attach board holding box to post with screws or double head nails, permitting easy removal if necessary to adjust box height.


#### Location of Mailbox Post



For <u>Rural Locations</u>, the face of the box shall be set back 8" to 12" from the edge of the turnout or useable shoulder.

For  $\underline{\text{Urban Locations}}$ , the face of the box shall be set back 6" to 12" from the face of the curb.

Dakota County will replace mailboxes with a standard size mailbox only when the box was installed at the proper height and location and when actually hit by snowplowing equipment. The Dakota County Transportation Department also will replace mailboxes damaged by snow coming off the plow when the mailbox has been installed on a swing or pivot support according to drawings available from the Dakota County Transportation Department.
