Project Overview

Dakota County and the City of Inver Grove Heights are developing plans for safety improvements along 80th Street E (County Road 28) between Babcock Trail and Bowman Avenue. The project will improve traffic safety and pedestrian safety along the corridor.

What is being done?

- The roadway is being converted from 4-lanes to 3-lanes from Babcock Trail to Bowman Avenue to improve traffic safety and pedestrian safety.
- Improve pedestrian crossings and accessibility throughout the corridor, particularly near Simley High School and Inver Grove Heights Middle School.
- Signal improvements at Blaine Ave.,
 Broderick Blvd., and Barnes Ave.

Why is the project needed?

- The 2021 Dakota County Pedestrian
 Crossing Safety Assessment recommended
 a lane reduction and pedestrian
 improvements along the corridor to improve
 the overall safety of the corridor.
- Three-lane roads improve traffic safety as they typically have lower crash and severity rates than multi-lane roads.
- Three-lane roads allow for safer pedestrian crossings due to the shorter crossing distance.

Timeline

DESIGN will continue through the end of 2024.

CONSTRUCTION will begin in the summer of 2025 and will be substantially complete prior to school starting in the fall of 2025.
