

#### County Highway 42 Management Plan (2022)






- 15-mile study corridor principal arterial (PA) highway
- 31 signalized intersections +approximately 90 non-signalized intersections
- With Cities, adopted strategies and concepts for intersections and segments Spring 2022

#### Overall Highway 42 Vision and Goals



- ✓ Reduce or defer need for Highway 42 expansion (through use of intersection controls)
- Maximize safety and efficient operations
- ✓ Maintain & improve corridor functions, serving all travelers
  - 2040 travel demand and beyond
  - All traveler modes ped, bike, bus transit, & motorists




#### Project Area Needs and Goals



- Replace obsolete infrastructure pavement, signals, underground utilities, retaining walls, intersection details, lighting
- Improve safety for all travelers pedestrians, bicyclists, and motorists
- No expansion of Highway 42 through lanes
- Improve travel efficiency in a mostly residential area (current conditions and future growth)
- 2027 construction Now working on design concepts and details;
   meet federal grant funding requirements

#### Project Improvements





- New tunnel under Co Hwy 42 for pedestrians and bicyclists to cross to each side of Redwood Park ...<u>concurrent with</u>...
- **2. Elm Drive modification** to manage left turns; remove the traffic signal
- Garden View Drive reconstruction to improve turn lanes, pedestrian crossings; replace signals
- 4. Hayes Road reconstruction to improve turn lanes, pedestrian crossings, and the retaining wall; replace signals
- 5. 147<sup>th</sup> Street reconstruction to manage left turns and improve multi-use trails east to Pennock Avenue
- Co Hwy 42 reconstruction, including the frontage roads, underground utilities
