


Lake Marion Greenway - Lakeville

PROJECT BACKGROUND:

The Lake Marion Greenway project in Lakeville is part of a larger 20-mile trail that travels through Burnsville, Savage, Credit River Township, Farmington, and Lakeville. This project begins just north of 209th Street, connecting to the existing greenway near downtown Lakeville and extends to Cedar Avenue. The greenway will link the Minnesota River and the Minnesota River Greenway to Murphy-Hanrehan Park Reserve, Ritter Farm Park, Lake Marion, downtown Lakeville, South Creek and downtown Farmington. It will connect with the North Creek Greenway in Farmington.



PROJECT OBJECTIVES:

This project will identify a preferred trail alignment, bridge crossings at South Creek and a grade-separated crossing design at Cedar Avenue. Other amenities include:

- Improve safety and accessibility of trail crossings
- Add connections to local trails and sidewalks
- Provide wayfinding and interpretive signage
- Add benches and landscaping
