

Lexington Avenue (County Road 43) between Cliff Road (County Road 32) and Wescott Road




# 2025 PROJECT ELEMENTS

Diffley Rd and Wescott Rd



Construct accessible pedestrian ramps



**Resurface** trails



Pedestrian crossing improvements



**Upgrade the signal system** at the Diffley Rd intersection



# Long-Term Intersection Concept — Northview Park Road




#### Benefits of a Roundabout Intersection


- Promote traffic calming

## WHAT TO EXPECT

### **Construction Work Hours**


Typically 7AM to 7PM Monday through Saturday



 Some evening and limited Sunday work will occur

### **Trail Access**

Trail traffic will be diverted to the opposite side of the road during



trail grading and paving and pedestrian ramp construction


#### Dust

Sweeping and water trucks will be used to minimize dust from work areas



### Restrictions

 Most work will be performed maintaining traffic in both directions



 Flaggers will be present at times to direct traffic



- Westbound
   Diffley Road
   traffic (west
   of Lexington Avenue) will
   be detoured during one
   weekend for storm sewer
   construction
- Vehicle traffic will be allowed on the milled roadway surface prior to paving
- The traffic signal at the Lexington Avenue / Diffley Road intersection will remain operational at all times
