

Phase 1 Engagement Summary

Study Overview

Dakota County and the City of Burnsville have begun a corridor study along McAndrews Road (County Road 38), from County Road 5 to Aldrich Avenue.

The study looks at current and future needs, traffic and safety data, and input from the community to find ways to improve safety and mobility and meet transportation goals.



Phase 1 Comment Themes

- Focus on intersections near Costco, particularly at Burnhaven Drive and 141st Street.
- Consider improvements at intersections serving the Cub and Salvation Army areas.
- Enhance safety at Burnhaven Drive and McAndrews Road due to high traffic volume and frequent backups.
- Ensure wide paths for walking and biking, especially near shopping and residential areas.
- Improve crosswalk visibility and frequency to enhance pedestrian safety.
- Install enhanced pedestrian infrastructure such as curb extensions and raised sidewalks to prevent drivers from stopping in crosswalks.
- Add traffic lights or roundabouts at key intersections like Irving Avenue, Aldrich Avenue, and 141st Street.
- Improve turn lanes and signal timings at busy intersections, particularly at County Road 5 and McAndrews Road.
- Consider adding dedicated left turn lanes and longer green lights for turning movements.
- Enforce speed limits more strictly and make adjustments where necessary.
- Implement roundabouts at high-traffic intersections without traffic lights to improve flow and reduce accidents.
