The Complainant submits this complaint to the Court and states that there is probable cause to believe Defendant committed the following offense(s):

COUNT I

Charge: Threats of Violence (Intent to Terrorize)

Minnesota Statute: 609.713.1

Maximum Sentence: 0-5 Years and/or \$3,000.00 - \$10,000.00

Offense Level: Felony

Offense Date (on or about): 08/01/2017

Control #(ICR#): 17004546

Charge Description: On or about August 1, 2017, in the County of Dakota, Minnesota, AHMED MOHAMED JAMA, did threaten, directly or indirectly, to commit any crime of violence with purpose to terrorize another or to cause evacuation of a building, place of assembly, vehicle or facility of public transportation or otherwise to cause serious public inconvenience, or in a reckless disregard of the risk of causing such terror or inconvenience.

STATEMENT OF PROBABLE CAUSE

On or about August 2, 2017, an Apple Valley police officer responded to the 12000 block of Glenbrook Way, Apple Valley, Dakota County, Minnesota, on a report of a past action domestic assault. Upon arrival, the officer spoke with N.O., who reported that she had gotten into an argument the evening before with her husband, Ahmed Mohamed Jama (DOB: 06/06/1998) (Defendant).

On August 1, 2017, at approximately 11:00 p.m., Defendant returned home and got into an argument with N.O. During the argument, Defendant threatened N.O., saying that he would shoot her in the head and get away with it. N.O. reported being afraid of Defendant and not feeling safe. Defendant had never threatened her like that before. Defendant is employed as a licensed peace officer and his duty weapon was in the residence at the time he made the threat.

Officers spoke with Defendant, who agreed to go to the police department to give a statement. Defendant admitted that they had argued, but claimed that it was more of a discussion. Defendant denied making the threat.

SIGNATURES AND APPROVALS

Complainant requests that Defendant, subject to bail or conditions of release, be:
(1) arrested or that other lawful steps be taken to obtain Defendant's appearance in court; or
(2) detained, if already in custody, pending further proceedings; and that said Defendant otherwise be dealt with according to law.

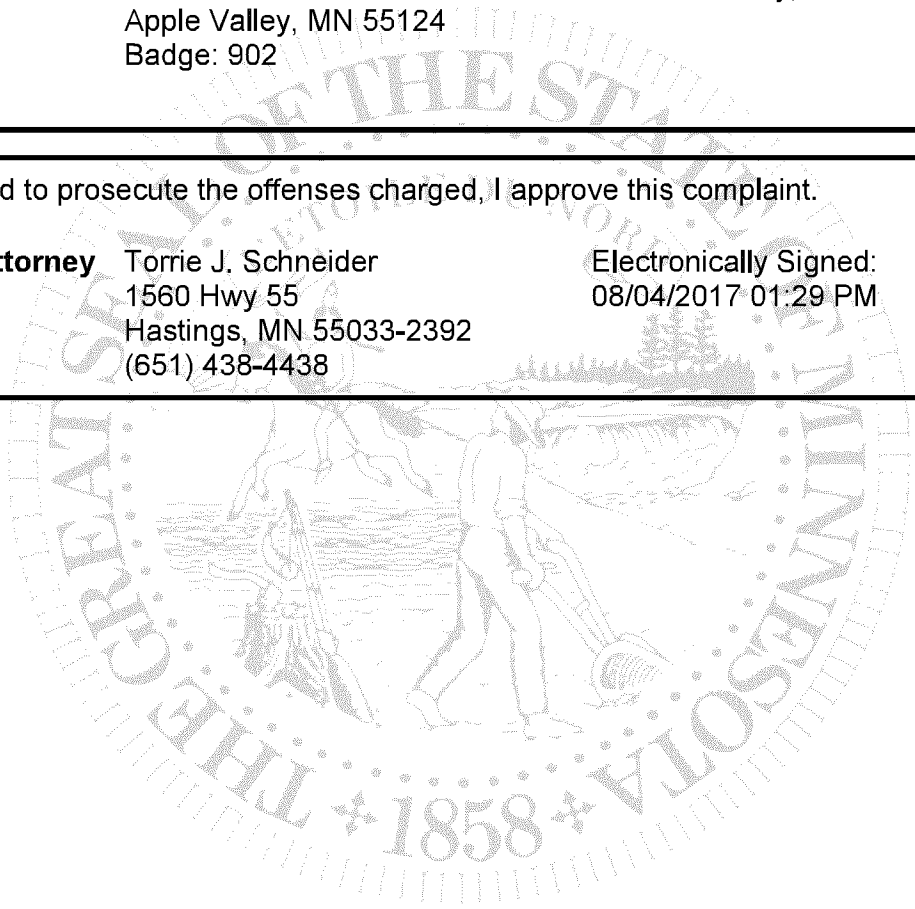
