COMPLAINT

Order of Detention

The Complainant submits this complaint to the Court and states that there is probable cause to believe Defendant committed the following offense(s):

COUNT I

Charge: Criminal Damage to Property in the 1st Degree (Value Reduced By More Than \$1,000)

Minnesota Statute: 609.595.1(4)

Maximum Sentence: 0-5 Years and/or \$3,000.00 - \$10,000.00

Offense Level: Felony

Offense Date (on or about): 03/15/2022

Control #(ICR#): 22000938

Charge Description: On or about March 15, 2022, in the County of Dakota, Minnesota, GAYLYNN ATLENE BAILEY, did intentionally cause damage to physical property of another without the other person's consent, and the damage reduced the value of the property by more than \$1,000 measured by the cost of repair and replacement.

STATEMENT OF PROBABLE CAUSE

On March 15, 2022 at approximately 9:43 a.m., officers were called to the report of a person destroying merchandise at Target in the City of West Saint Paul, County of Dakota, State of Minnesota. Store employees told officers that the suspect, later identified as GAYLYNN ATLENE BAILEY (DOB: 10/22/1998), entered the store at approximately 9:41 a.m. and began throwing merchandise on the floor, smashing display cases, and knocking over display stands.

Officers entered the store and located BAILEY in the electronics department and saw BAILEY knocking boxed televisions onto the ground. BAILEY was ordered to stop and get on the ground, but she instead continued to throw items off the shelves. Officers were then able to approach BAILEY and take her into custody. As officers were escorting BAILEY out of the store at approximately 9:52 a.m., she continued to kick at merchandise on the floor and at display stands.

Store employees provided officers with surveillance footage from the store showing BAILEY pouring chocolate sauce, laundry detergent, and windshield washer fluid on the store's floor, breaking glass display cases with a golf club and hand weights, and ripping a laptop off of a security tether and throwing it on the ground. The value of the items damaged by BAILEY at the time of writing was \$6,988.95 with the possibility that the value will increase as store employees continue to examine merchandise.

SIGNATURES AND APPROVALS

Complainant requests that Defendant, subject to bail or conditions of release, be:
(1) arrested or that other lawful steps be taken to obtain Defendant's appearance in court; or
(2) detained, if already in custody, pending further proceedings; and that said Defendant otherwise be dealt with according to law.
