COMPLAINT

Order of Detention

The Complainant submits this complaint to the Court and states that there is probable cause to believe Defendant committed the following offense(s):

COUNT I

Charge: Possession of Firearm by Ineligible Person (Prior Crime of Violence)

Minnesota Statute: 624.713.1(2), with reference to: 624.713.2(b), 609.11.5

Maximum Sentence: 5-15 Years and/or \$9,000.00 - \$30,000.00

Offense Level: Felony

Offense Date (on or about): 06/03/2023

Control #(ICR#): 23404002

Charge Description: On or about June 3, 2023, in the County of Dakota, Minnesota, ANWAR SHERIFE MANNING, did unlawfully possess a pistol, a semiautomatic military-style assault weapon or any other firearm, after having been convicted of, or adjudicated delinquent or convicted as an extended jurisdiction juvenile for committing in this state or elsewhere, a crime of violence and at the time of offense, the Defendant or an accomplice did use or possess a firearm, to wit: handgun.

On June 3, 2023, at approximately 5:20 p.m., a state trooper responded to a report of a possible domestic incident involving a male and female on I-35E near Highway 77 in Burnsville, Dakota County, Minnesota.

Upon arrival, the trooper observed a male and a female walking away from a Ford Explorer, which was in the center median of I-35E. The male was later identified as ANWAR SHERIFE MANNING (DOB: 10/01/1981). The trooper attempted to speak with MANNING and the female. The female indicated they were having car trouble and were attempting to walk to the exit to County Road 11, specifically a gas station thereabouts. The trooper offered to give MANNING and a female a ride to the gas station as it was unsafe for them to walk on the freeway.

The trooper explained that he would need to pat them down for weapons before letting them enter his squad. The trooper quickly checked the female for weapons. As he did so, MANNING began backing away. The trooper told MANNING that he did not want him walking on the freeway. MANNING continued walking away and eventually fled across the westbound lanes of traffic. The trooper gave chase. In MANNING's right hand, the trooper clearly observed a black handgun. As he ran after MANNING, the trooper instructed MANNING to drop the gun and that he was under arrest.

MANNING ran through a forested area and around a pond. MANNING climbed over a fence and into a backyard. Troopers eventually located MANNING hiding under a tree in the backyard. Troopers arrested MANNING. MANNING no longer had the gun. When asked about the gun, MANNING stated, "it was my phone man, not a gun!" MANNING complained of pain, so he was transported by ambulance to a hospital nearby.

In a post-Miranda statement, MANNING stated, "I wanna apologize man to man" and "I didn't mean to put you through that." MANNING claimed that he ran because he was scared and thought he had active warrants. MANNING denied having a firearm and claimed it was a butane torch. MANNING could not explain why he would get rid of a butane torch.

The Minnesota State Patrol, Dakota County Dive Team, Dakota County K9 Unit, and other law enforcement agencies are in the process of locating the firearm. On February 14, 2009, MANNING was

convicted of Assault in the Second Degree (court file no.: 27-CR-09-8235). MANNING is prohibited from possessing firearms or ammunition.

SIGNATURES AND APPROVALS

Complainant requests that Defendant, subject to bail or conditions of release, be:
(1) arrested or that other lawful steps be taken to obtain Defendant's appearance in court; or
(2) detained, if already in custody, pending further proceedings; and that said Defendant otherwise be dealt with according to law.

Complainant declares under penalty of perjury that everything stated in this document is true and correct. Minn. Stat. § 358.116; Minn. R. Crim. P. 2.01, subds. 1, 2.

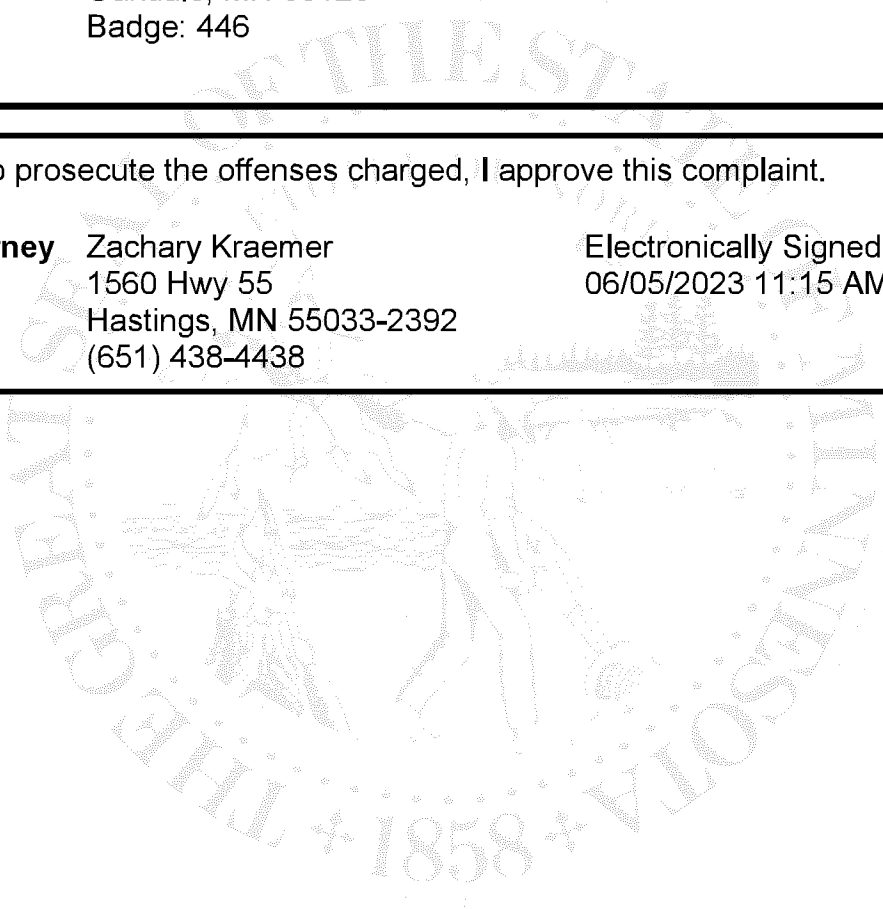
