The Complainant submits this complaint to the Court and states that there is probable cause to believe Defendant committed the following offense(s):

Charge Description: On or about August 12, 2023 - September 12, 2023, in the County of Dakota, Minnesota, MITCHELL JAMES OMODT, did intentionally and without claim of right take, use, transfer, conceal or retain possession of movable property of another without the other's consent and with intent to deprive the owner permanently of possession of the property, and the aggregate value of the property or services stolen exceeds \$5,000.

19HA-CR-23-2501 STATEMENT OF PROBABLE CAUSE

On September 22, 2023, the Burnsville Police Department was contacted by a corporate investigator with Home Depot about a series of retail thefts in the metro area. The investigator stated that MITCHELL JAMES OMODT (DOB: 10/16/1995) had attempted to steal tools from various Home Depot locations on 23 separate occasions. OMODT would select high value items, proceed to the self-checkout, pretend to swipe a credit card, or swipe a canceled credit card, and then leave the store without paying. OMODT's scheme was successful on seven occasions:

- On August 12, 2023, OMODT stole \$1,186.37 worth of merchandise from the Waite Park Home Depot.
- On August 12, 2023, OMODT stole \$811.94 worth of merchandise from the Monticello Home Depot.
- On August 31, 2023, OMODT stole \$823.41 worth of merchandise from the Inver Grove Heights Home Depot.
- On September 5, 2023, OMODT stole \$1,164.88 worth of merchandise from the Baxter Home Depot.
- On September 8, 2023, OMODT stole \$1,042.58 worth of merchandise from the Apple Valley Home Depot.
- On September 10, 2023, OMODT stole \$1,027.28 worth of merchandise from the Richfield Home Depot.
- On September 12, 2023, OMODT stole \$272.93 worth of merchandise from the Inver Grove Heights Home Depot.

The aggregate loss to Home Depot was \$6,329.34 with three of the thefts occurring in Dakota County. The corporate investigator also provided surveillance footage of each of the thefts.

On September 25, 2023, a detective spoke with OMODT by telephone. OMODT admitted to stealing from various Home Depot stores to support his drug addiction. OMODT estimated that he stole from Home Depot on 10-15 occasions. OMODT alluded to selling or giving the stolen merchandise to other people because "everyone needs them."
