COMPLAINT

Order of Detention

The Complainant submits this complaint to the Court and states that there is probable cause to believe Defendant committed the following offense(s):

COUNT I**Charge: Receiving Stolen Property (Over \$1,000 up to \$5,000)**

Minnesota Statute: 609.53.1, with reference to: 609.52.3(3)(a)

Maximum Sentence: 0-5 Years and/or \$3,000.00 - \$10,000.00

Offense Level: Felony

Offense Date (on or about): 04/08/2024

Control #(ICR#): 24001713

Charge Description: On or about April 8, 2024, in the County of Dakota, Minnesota, ANWAR SHERIFE MANNING, did receive, possess, transfer, buy or conceal any stolen property or property obtained by robbery, knowing or having reason to know the property was stolen or obtained by robbery, and the value of the property or services stolen is more than \$1,000 but not more than \$5,000.

On April 8, 2024, at approximately 6:00 p.m., a police officer responded to a report of past-action theft from a vehicle in Burnsville, Dakota County, Minnesota. The reporting party (hereinafter "Victim") stated that someone had broken into his truck overnight. Victim stated that he was missing his laptop, four sets of headphones, a key fob, two pairs of running shoes, and a gym bag. The aggregate value of the missing property was more than \$1,000.00.

Victim tracked the location of his headphones to a residence in Burnsville. Victim spoke with an identified female at the residence. Victim requested his missing items, and the female went inside the residence to look for them. The female returned and provided a backpack and duffle bag to Victim. Victim recorded the interaction on his cell phone.

Police officers arrived and spoke with the female. The female suspected that her husband had brought the items to the residence. The husband was identified as ANWAR SHERIFE MANNING (DOB: 11/01/1981). MANNING exited the residence and spoke with police officers. The police officers asked MANNING how he came into possession of the stolen property. MANNING explained that his little cousin hit a "f*****g lick" and picked him up. MANNING stated that he purchased the items from his cousin for a "zip" of "weed." MANNING claimed that the only thing he paid for was the laptop, but there were other items in the bag. MANNING denied stealing the items.

Complainant requests that Defendant, subject to bail or conditions of release, be:
(1) arrested or that other lawful steps be taken to obtain Defendant's appearance in court; or
(2) detained, if already in custody, pending further proceedings; and that said Defendant otherwise be dealt with according to law.

Complainant declares under penalty of perjury that everything stated in this document is true and correct. Minn. Stat. § 358.116; Minn. R. Crim. P. 2.01, subds. 1, 2.
