COMPLAINT

Order of Detention

The Complainant submits this complaint to the Court and states that there is probable cause to believe Defendant committed the following offense(s):

COUNT I

Charge: Possession of Firearm by Ineligible Person (Prior Crime of Violence)

Minnesota Statute: 624.713.1(2), with reference to: 624.713.2(b), 609.11.5

Maximum Sentence: 5-15 Years and/or \$9,000.00 - \$30,000.00

Offense Level: Felony

Offense Date (on or about): 11/03/2024

Control #(ICR#): 24006336

Charge Description: On or about November 3, 2024, in the County of Dakota, Minnesota, THOMAS GORDON LOSIE did unlawfully possess a pistol, a semiautomatic military-style assault weapon, or any other firearm, after having been convicted of, or adjudicated delinquent or convicted as an extended jurisdiction juvenile for committing in this state or elsewhere, a crime of violence; and at the time of offense, the Defendant or an accomplice did use or possess a firearm, to wit: a 9mm Ruger handgun.

COUNT II

Charge: Threats of Violence (Intent to Terrorize)

Minnesota Statute: 609.713.1

Maximum Sentence: 0-5 Years and/or \$3,000.00 - \$10,000.00

Offense Level: Felony

Offense Date (on or about): 11/03/2024

Control #(ICR#): 24006336

Charge Description: On or about November 3, 2024, in the County of Dakota, Minnesota, THOMAS GORDON LOSIE did threaten, directly or indirectly, to commit any crime of violence with purpose to terrorize another or to cause evacuation of a building, place of assembly, vehicle or facility of public transportation or otherwise to cause serious public inconvenience, or in a reckless disregard of the risk of causing such terror or inconvenience.

STATEMENT OF PROBABLE CAUSE

On November 3, 2024, Victim, a resident of Apple Valley, Dakota County, came to the police department and reported that her husband, THOMAS GORDON LOSIE (DOB: 01/09/1976), Defendant herein, had been behaving erratically and waving a gun around at their house. Victim indicated that Defendant had been using drugs due to back issues and also had insomnia, resulting in him being up for extended periods of time. Victim described Defendant as having been agitated that day and aggressive towards her. Defendant punched a mirror and cut his hand during an argument. Defendant took car keys and left. Victim also left the residence and returned later to check on Defendant. Victim noticed at that time that a gun she had hidden was missing. Victim heard some music and realized Defendant was home. Defendant was in a bedroom with the gun next to him. Defendant pointed the gun at Victim and told her to leave him alone or he would shoot her in the face the next time she came in. Victim left the house and went to the police Department.

Officers went to the residence and attempted to make contact with Defendant. Defendant did not initially respond but eventually came out and was taken into custody. Defendant said Victim bought the gun and he did not know where it was kept. A search warrant was executed at the residence to locate the gun described by Victim. During execution of the warrant, officers located a 9mm Ruger handgun under a couch cushion in the living room that had a chambered round. Defendant and Victim's bedroom contained a gun case for a .38 Smith and Wesson revolver under the bed. A bedside table contained Defendant's ID card, along with several prescription bottles and clonazepam pills and open Suboxone packets. The bottom shelf of the table had a piece of 9mm Ruger ammunition. A 50-count box of 9 mm ammunition was also found on the carpet next to the table. A closet in the bedroom contained numerous boxes, cartridges, and loose pieces of ammunition, two Glock magazines, a Glock owner's manual, a baggie of mushrooms, a baggie of a purple crystal substance, and numerous prescription bottles in Defendant's name. The TV stand had another of Defendant's ID cards with a yellow envelope labeled as "Glock Model 41 manufacturer's test-fire casings" that was issued with a Glock model weapon.

Defendant is ineligible to possess a firearm due to a felony conviction for 3rd Degree Assault on 09/26/1995 in 19-K7-95-000851.

SIGNATURES AND APPROVALS

Complainant requests that Defendant, subject to bail or conditions of release, be:
(1) arrested or that other lawful steps be taken to obtain Defendant's appearance in court; or
(2) detained, if already in custody, pending further proceedings; and that said Defendant otherwise be dealt with according to law.
