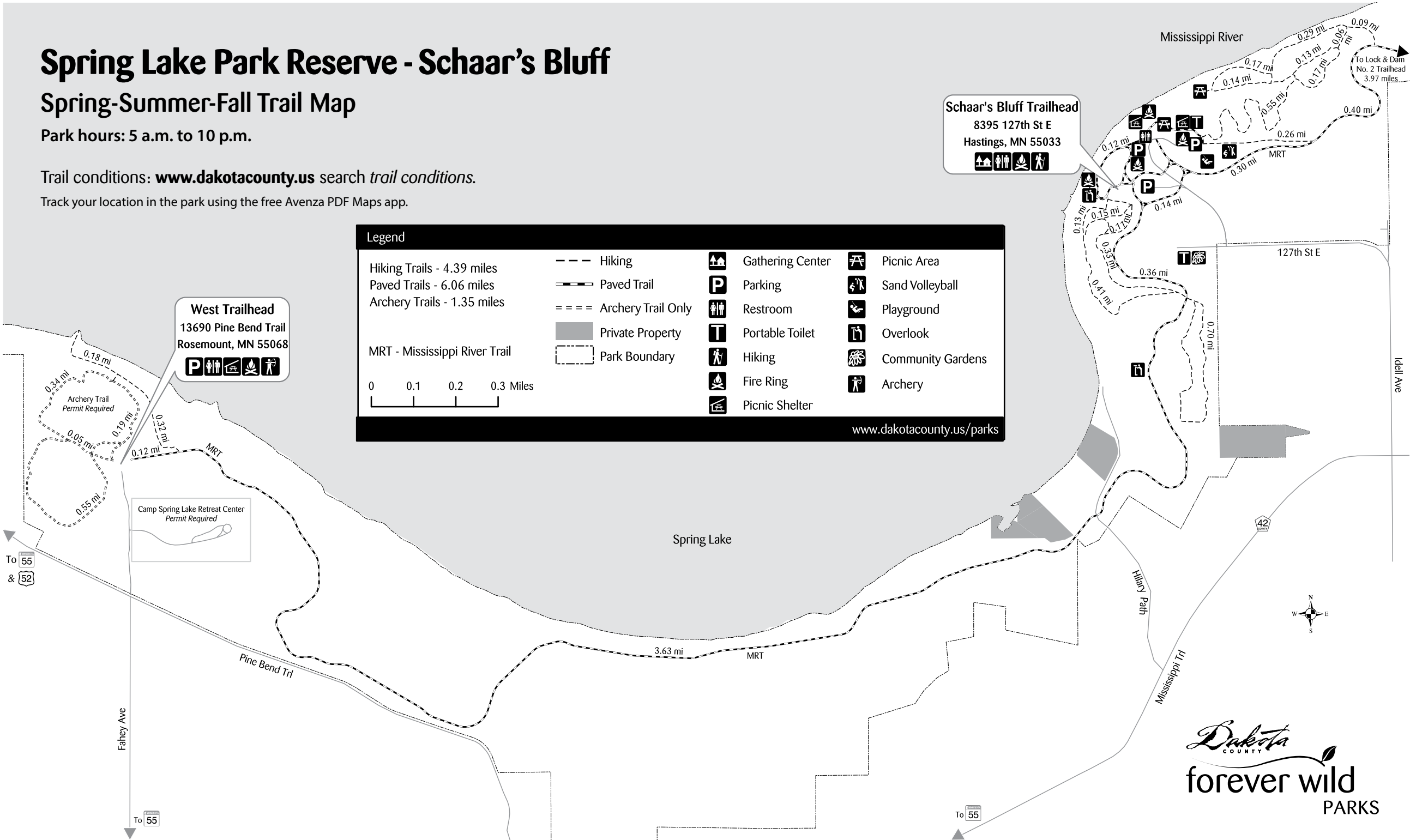

Spring Lake Park Reserve

Welcome to Spring Lake Park Reserve. This park is a rest stop along the 3,000-mile Great River Road and offers miles of bluff top trails with a bird's-eye view of the Mississippi River.

Spring Lake Park Reserve is part of the Dakota County Park System.

Admission and parking are free.

Park features

- Schaar's Center Bluff Gathering Center (open year-round)
- Retreat Center with Group Camping (open year round)
- Wooded archery trail (open late spring-fall)
- 4+ miles of nature trails for hiking
- Mississippi River Trail
- Scenic overlook

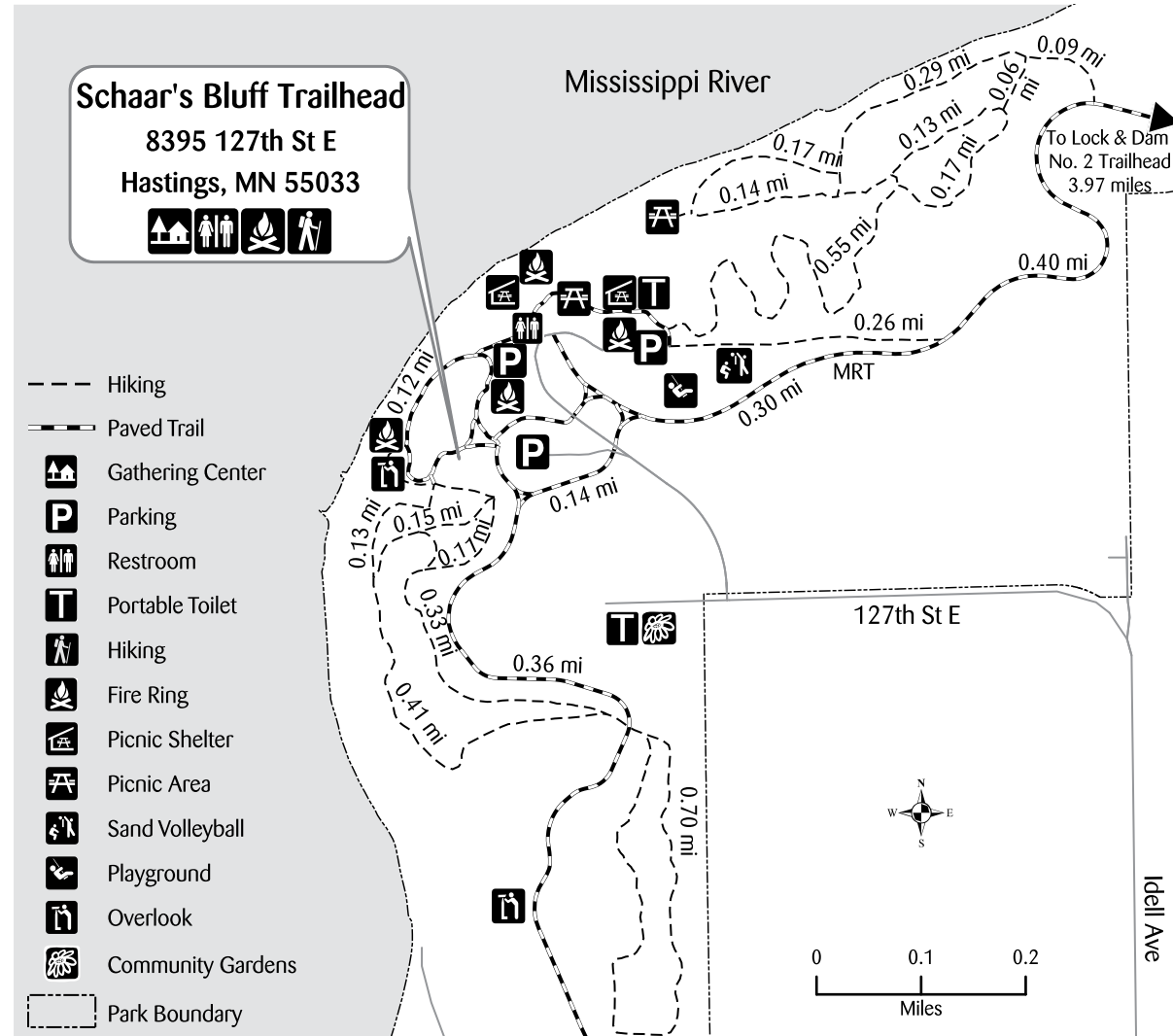
- Use trails for their intended purpose.

Archery Trail Pass

A Dakota County Parks archery trail pass is required for archers age 18 and older. Season passes are \$30+tax and available online at www.dakotacounty.us, at the Western Service Center or by phone at 952-891-7000. Daily passes are available online and by pay box at the West Trailhead for \$5.
