**Ceremony Site:** Please return the ceremony area and surrounding grounds to a ready-to-use condition.

□ **Trash/Recycling:** Pick up **ALL** trash and recycling from the site and surrounding area and haul to trash/recycling cans or nearby recycling station/dumpster (if available).

Overflow trash/recycling should be packed out: Please do not leave trash/recycling stacked next to or on top of full cans or dumpsters.

Grounds: Remove all temporary signs, stakes, banners and decorations. Remove all personal items.

□ **Fire Rings:** Extinguish fire in outdoor fire ring prior to your departure.

□ **Picnic Tables:** Return picnic tables to designated area. A-frame standard layout has 4 tables under shelter.

## \*Firewood Restrictions:

Dakota County Parks prohibits any split log or log firewood from being brought into any Dakota County Park facilities to prevent the spread of invasive and damaging pests including the Emerald Ash Borer.

Kiln dried wood such as unpainted and unstained dimension lumber or kindling that is free of any metal or foreign substance can be brought in.

Firewood can be purchased from Minnesota DNR approved venders, the Lebanon Hills Campground in Apple Valley, Lake Byllesby Campground in Cannon Falls and at the Lebanon Hills Visitor Center in Eagan.
