Bring your broken items to a Fix-It Clinic for free repair help



Dakota County residents can get help repairing household items, clothes, electronics and more at a Fix-It Clinic. These monthly events help keep items out of landfills and empower people to repair things on their own.

Show up to the upcoming Fix-It Clinic on [enter day, month and date] from [enter time] at [enter facility] in [enter city]. The event is free, and you do not need to register to participate.

Helpful volunteers will guide you through each step, help you troubleshooting to a completed repair. Bring up to three items that need fixing or mending such as lamps, vacuum cleaners and clothes. You must be able to carry items into the clinic, so no overly large items. Bring any tools and supplies you think might help with the job, but it is not required to bring any tools.
