protect public health and safety, groundwater quality and to prevent or eliminate
the development of public nuisances.

Application Procedures

- 1 Review and follow the Borrower Owner Check List, included with this application.
2 Complete the application and return to the County at the address listed above.
3 No septic work can be started before approval of the application to be included in the assessment.
4 The applicant(s) must sign and return a copy of the "Notice to Landowner" with the application.
5 After the system has been installed and inspected, the applicant/Owner must sign and return the original signed and notarized copy of the Agreement of Assessment and Waiver of Irregularity and Appeal.
