Unemployment Insurance benefits provide a temporary partial wage replacement to workers who become unemployed through no fault of their own.

If you have become unemployed or had your hours greatly reduced, complete the Application Process – Minnesota Unemployment Insurance will determine whether or not you are eligible and will notify you.
