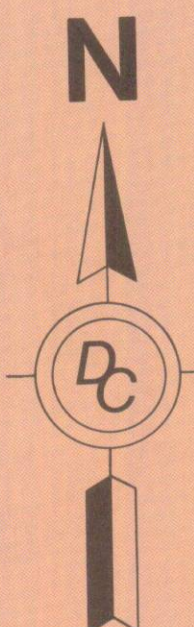

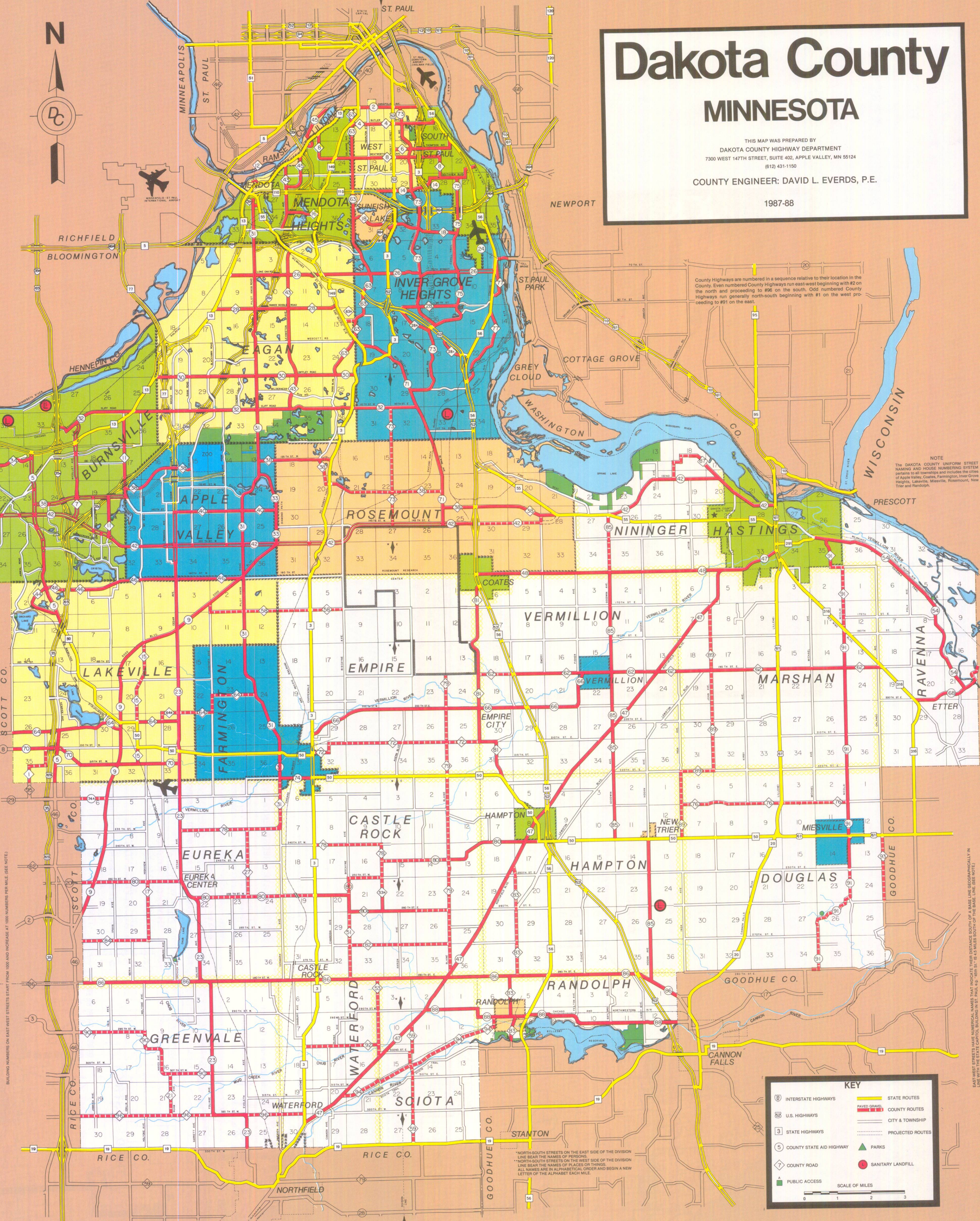

County Highways are numbered in a sequence relative to their location in the County. Even numbered County Highways run east-west beginning with #2 on the north and proceeding to #96 on the south. Odd numbered County Highways run generally north-south beginning with #1 on the west proceeding to #91 on the east.

NOTE  
THE DAKOTA COUNTY UNIFORM STREET NAMING AND HOUSE NUMBERING SYSTEM pertains to all townships and includes the cities of Apple Valley, Coates, Farmington, Inver Grove Heights, Lakeville, Miesville, Rosemount, New Trier and Randolph.



BUILDING NUMBERS ON EAST-WEST STREETS START FROM 1000 AND INCREASE AT 1000 NUMBERS PER MILE (SEE NOTE)

EAST-WEST STREETS HAVE NUMERICAL NAMES THAT INDICATE THE NUMBER OF MILES SOUTH OF A BASE LINE (GEOGRAPHICALLY IN LINE WITH THE STATE CAPITAL BUILDING IN ST. PAUL) AS 1000 FEET SOUTH OF THE BASE LINE (SEE NOTE)

\*NORTH-SOUTH STREETS ON THE EAST SIDE OF THE DIVISION LINE BEAR THE NAMES OF PERSONS.  
\*NORTH-SOUTH STREETS ON THE WEST SIDE OF THE DIVISION LINE BEAR THE NAMES OF PLACES OR THINGS.  
ALL NAMES ARE IN ALPHABETICAL ORDER AND BEGIN A NEW LETTER OF THE ALPHABET EACH MILE.
